Early Years Continued: 3 Tibet Conferences:

Road to Independence, etc: [Phil Ladenla]



His Holiness the Dalai Lama receives the 1989 Nobel Peace Prize.

- In the late 80's and early 90's, 3 conferences were held to focus on issues of great relevance to the Tibetan struggle:
 - 1988: <u>Five Point Peace Plan</u>, proposed by His Holiness the Dalai Lama (1987)
 - 1990: <u>Endangered Tibet</u> the ecological disaster facing Tibet
 - 1992: <u>Tibet: The Road to Independence</u> commemorating the International Year of Tibet, 1991-1992

- June, 1994: Tibetan community of SF Bay Area joins local Chinese community to *commemorate Tiananmen Square Massacre*, organized in conjunction with TANC
- June, 1995: Tibetan community of SF Bay Area demonstrates at 50th anniversary of the founding of the *United Nations, demonstrations* organized by BAFoT and TANC
- <u>1996</u>: BAFoT representatives attend *international TSG conference* in Washington, DC
- January, 1997: Third Western Region Tibet Support Group conference held in SF, co-sponsored by BAFoT and seven other TSGs; representatives from 30 TSGs from 14 western states attended
- June, 1997: BAFoT co-sponsored and coordinated a public talk by HHDL and two other Nobel Peace Prize winners (Jose Ramos-Horta and Rigoberta Menchu)





1990s, continued

- Co-sponsorship and organization of the following:
 - annual Losar celebration
 - annual Tibetan Uprising demonstrations
 - annual Tibet Day celebration
 - annual celebration of HHDL's birthday in July
 - annual International Human Rights Day demonstrations






