In Summer 2013 they will tour throughout the West Coast, Midwest and East Coast. Techung and his band look forward to their debut appearance in Chicago.

Techung is regarded as the key-holder of traditional Tibetan music, having studied it formally in Dharamshala, India at the Tibetan Institute of Performing Arts (TIPA), where he was a student and performer from the ages of 9 to 26. He now resides in the USA but tours regularly. Also known as Tashi Dhondup Sharzur, he uses his childhood nickname "Techung" as a moniker. Techung's main instrument is his voice; he also plays long neck lute or *Dramnyen*, Tibetan fiddle or *Piwang* and bamboo flute or *Lingbu*.

After immigrating to the USA in 1989, Techung co-founded *Chaksampa* Tibetan Dance and Opera Company, performing traditional Tibetan opera throughout the U.S. Europe and Asia. Recently he founded a contemporary internationally touring band, Lhasa Spirits. He is a major force in the preservation of traditional Tibetan vocal and instrumental traditions, drawing on both his heritage and other musical traditions and can be heard on over 12 solo and collaborative albums. Techung is widely respected for the original solo and collaborative music he creates, joining with him on stage are the profoundly talented Michel Tyabji, percussion; Kito Rodriguez, Bass and Rinzing Wangyal, Guitar.
