- Vendor/Non-Profit agrees to maintain dignity and the integrity of the event and will not perform any harmful acts.
- As the Producers of the event we reserve the right to ask any Vendor/Non-Profit or its employees to leave if felt that they are not acting in the best interest of the festival and its attendees.
- Vendor/Non-Profits agree to permit photography of their booths during the 2010 festival by festival staff to be used for the purposes of promoting and advertising future events.
- All photography taken remain the property of Bay Area Friends of Tibet and will not be sold or used for other purposes.
- The producers of the event will not be liable for any refunds or any other liabilities in the
